Bee Card Accessibility concession holders always receive free travel.




As part of the Government's Community Connect initiative those travelling with a registered Bee Card in the following groups will receive free or reduced fares:


Transport options

 Buses leave from Quay St (800m/10 min walk) towards the city centre.




On board

How to pay

Te Huia is a public transport service, so you don't book a seat* or pay in advance - everything is done on the train, on the day.

If you're using a Bee Card, the train manager will come through the carriage to take your fare. You can pay for two or more people on a single Bee Card.

If you're paying the cash fare, you'll need to do this at the on board cafe.


